Growing Daylilies From Seed

- 1) We recommend starting seed indoors where you can have control over the environment.
- 2) Start seed at room temperature.
- 3) Use a clean pot that has drainage holes.
- 4) Fill pot $\frac{3}{4}$ full with your favourite seed starting soil-less mix or sterilized soil mix. We use 3 parts peat moss, 1 part vermiculite, 1 part perlite.
- 5) Moisten soil.
- 6) Place seed on soil 3 cm apart.
- 7) Cover seed with 2 cm of seed starting mix. Pat the soil to ensure seed to soil contact.
- 8) Cover pot to retain the moisture. Keep soil damp but not wet.
- 9) Sturdy little green seedlings should start appearing at 2 weeks, and will keep coming up for an additional 2 weeks.
- 10) Remove pot cover to allow for air movement as the seedlings begin to appear.
- 11) Plant outdoors anytime between last frost in spring to July 15.
- 12) 2 to 3 years from seed to bloom.
