Growing Martagon Lilies From Seed (leuan Evans Method)

- 1. In Autumn. Fill clear containers (with lids) with slightly damp peat moss. When you squeeze the peat moss, your hand should be barely moist.
- 2. Mix in your martagon seeds. You can have 100 seeds in a half litre container.
- 3. Label the container with weatherproof label/marker.
- 4. Place containers in a transparent bag to observe growth, and prevent moisture loss.
- 5. Keep at room temperature until around January 1^{st} .
- 6. January 1st, place the containers into the fridge for 3-4 months.
- 7. In April/May take out of fridge. Growth will be started.
- 8. Dig a small trench where you want to put your lily seedlings. Take the container of martagon babies (a mass of roots and bulbs), and dump them into the trench. Don't break up into individual bulbs, they will die. Let them just be.
- 9. Cover with an inch of soil.
- 10. Watch them grow!
- 11. Approximately 3 to 4 years to flower.
